

TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Psychology

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate of Arts at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Arts in Psychology at McKendree University.

Admission Requirements

Upon completion of the requirements leading to the Associate of Arts Degree, KCTCS graduates who meet McKendree's admission requirements of a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average will be selected for admission to the Bachelor of Arts in Psychology. McKendree's Bachelor of Arts in Psychology program is available at Lebanon, IL and online. Apply for admission at apply.mckendree.edu.

Degree Requirements

McKendree University accepts the Associate of Arts from KCTCS as fulfilling all general education requirements. Students must have a minimum of 120 credits to receive a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology degree. McKendree accepts up to 90 hours in transfer credit. Residency with McKendree is a minimum of 30 hours (which must be upper level hours).

General Transfer Requirements

- Apply for admission apply.mckendree.edu.
- Enrollments accepted five times per year.
- 10% tuition discount for all KCTCS graduates enrolled in a McKendree Worldwide program.*
- Phi Theta Kappa 15% tuition discount available for KCTCS graduates enrolled in a McKendree Worldwide program.*
- Active duty military \$250 per credit hour tuition rate and no additional fees when enrolled in a McKendree Worldwide program.*
- Transfer scholarships available to students attending the Lebanon, IL campus.
